Pray First, and consider these great opportunities!

- Begin a Discipleship/Study Group or Prayer Group. (Need Guidance? See Stephen)
- Conduct Bible Correspondence with Sumner County Jail inmates.
- Donate soft-cover Bibles and/or **plastic framed *Reading Glasses** for SCJ inmates.
- *The SCJ is in desperate need for someone to coordinate a consistent donation of reading glasses. We are currently distributing more than 100 per month. 1.00-3.25 strength. They must be plastic framed and can be purchased for \$1 a piece at The Dollar Tree.
- Contribute to our Old Union food pantry ministry.
- Visit the residents of Morningside. Sundays are great, but the residents are there daily too.
- Consider becoming a mentor for the Chosen Ladies.
- The Chosen Lady ministry is currently in need of day-time drivers too!
- Design posters and signs that incorporate our OUKids memory goals.
- Challenge yourself to join in with OUKids. Sit up front, memorize, be excited with them!
- Help develop and lead community outreach plans. Our neighborhood is growing!
- Pray daily for our leadership and look for opportunities to help them.**
- Help plan an event that brings our church family closer together.
- Check with those we have not seen in while. Your concern could make the difference!
- Invite a visitor to lunch with you today. Be interruptible!
- Pray about becoming a foster or adoptive parent. Talk with those who have already.
- Consider spending time on a mission trip with your family.
